The 2018 wines have all completed fermentation, and the quality is excellent. We have our first (small) vintage of Laleure Sauvignon Blanc that was planted 3 years ago, and it is tasting great. Can't wait til the spring when it will be ready for bottling. Over the winter we will be doing lots of bottling, including Pinot Noir, Cabernet Franc, Chambourcin, Chardonnay, and our newly planned blend we are calling Paradox.
