Laleure will host a Chardonnay Vertical event on Saturday May 8 at 6:30 pm. Our participants get to check out Laleure Chard's from our library collection, current offerings, and selected barrels. We will include some of our oldest vintages, including 2005 and likely our 2002 and others from our library collection. Amazing fun, comparing the vintage growing, picking, and processing aspects and relating them to nose, fruit characteristics, tannins, body, and so much more.

The fee is \$110 for a couple or pair, or \$70 for an individual. The fee includes a bottle of your favorite Laleure Chardonnay currently offered for sale, as well as an individual complimentary cheese and cracker platter. Please contact us early if you wish to attend, the registration is very limited to make this a special experience, and based on the pinot experience, is expected to sell-out quickly.
