The mild winter was gentle on the vines, leaving us with healthy buds and lots of hope for a great 2017 season. The weather has things going on about 10 days ahead of normal, but we are all pruned & tied up, hoping that the gentle spring continues without any serious frost over the next few weeks.

News from the winery

We managed to continue to supply our wines at Laleure from stock despite the loss of crops in 2014 (100%), and 2015 (85%). We are thankful for the excellent 2016 season which was larger than most years, and are counting on the 2016 wines, particularly the whites, to keep the stock up of our Vignoles, Three Dog White, Riesling, and Rosé. Of course we keep our reds for many years, so have ample barrel reserves for them.

Laleure entered just a couple wines into an international competition and were awarded a Silver medal for our 2010 Cabernet Franc and Bronze for the 2013 Chardonnay. Come out and try them!
