The vines are all pruned and tied, and we are in the process of "un-mounding" the protective earth layer that we "mounded up" in the fall. It has been a bit wet this spring, sometimes making it difficult to get into the vineyards to work, but that seems over and all is well.

News from the winery

The 2018 wines have all completed fermentation, cold stabilization and multiple rackings. Once we finish up the critical spring work in the vineyards we will begin to move some wines to oak, and bottle others. First in line is a new Rosé, and then our latest "sur lis" chardonnay. Then on to some new cab franc vintages and our new Paradox blend.
