*The Harvest - Another successful harvest was completed at the end of October, with all the wines now finished primary fermentation. The quality of the fruit was generally excellent, and with great chemistry promises to make excellent 2025 vintage wines.*

*New Wine Releases - A number of wines have been released recently, including the 2024 Parkman Hill Bianca and 2024 Riesling. Stop by to check them out! Both were included in the Wine & Cheese Pairing event with Marchant Manor Cheese of Cleveland Heights and received great reviews. Other recent releases since late summer include our 2022 Dry Riesling, 2024 Sauvignon blanc, 2023 Vignoles, and the very popular 2024 Silo.*

*Sparkling Wines on Tap - Another first for the tasting room, we now offer sparkling wines on tap. The first to be on tap (now) is our 2023 Parkman Hill Bianca, and it is delicious. We soon will offer our 2023 Riesling. The selections will increase as we learn more about this new capability.*
